## Recycle

### Newspapers, Magazines, Misc. paper products

- ◇ All white & colored writing/ computer paper
- ◇ Newspapers/Inserts
- ◇ Corrugated cardboard
- ◇ Phone books
- ◇ Magazines/Catalogs
- ◇ Boxboard from chip, cereal, & cracker boxes

### Tin, Aerosol/Aluminum Cans

- ◇ Food & pet food cans
- ◇ Pop & Beer cans
- ◇ Clean aluminum foil & aluminum foil pans

### Glass

- ◇ Clear, green, brown or blue food or beverage containers
- ◇ Wine, beer & other alcohol bottles
- ◇ Pop & Salad Dressing bottles

### Plastic

- ◇ Two liter bottles
- ◇ Plastic milk jugs
- ◇ Bleach bottles
- ◇ All plastic bottles & jugs with a screw top lid or that have a neck smaller than the base.

# DON'T

## Recycle

- ◇ Styrofoam
- ◇ Garbage
- ◇ Pizza Boxes, egg cartons, ice cream cartons
- ◇ Plastic grocery bags
- ◇ Softener Salt Bags
- ◇ Baby/adult diapers
- ◇ Hazardous Waste
- ◇ Scrap metal (metal pipe, hangers, wires, car parts)
- ◇ Hot or cold ashes
- ◇ Concrete, rocks, gravel, or wood
- ◇ Snack food bags (chips or popcorn)
- ◇ Fast food containers, cups, or wrappers
- ◇ Foam cups /containers or Styrofoam peanuts
- ◇ Bubble wrap
- ◇ Plastic toys/furniture
- ◇ Plastic film/wrap or dry cleaning bags, Milk bags
- ◇ String, twine, cotton balls
- ◇ Paper towels, napkins, tissues
- ◇ Garden product containers (pesticide)
- ◇ Cups, coffee filters, tea bags
- ◇ Waxed paper or waxed anything (milk cartons, drinking boxes, frozen food boxes)
- ◇ Candy/gum wrappers, toilet paper
- ◇ Photos, slides, or transparencies
- ◇ Paint cans, Motor oil, gas containers
- ◇ Light bulbs, pens, drinking glasses
- ◇ Window glass, mirrors
- ◇ Pottery, ceramics
- ◇ Disposable razors, needles
- ◇ Toys, dishes, glasses, medicine containers
